



Professional License Reciprocity Disclosure

Georgia Career Institute will provide programs of study that meet the minimum curriculum requirements as prescribed by the State of Georgia (Main Campus) and the State of Tennessee (Branch Campus).

For states outside of Georgia and Tennessee: the institution has not made a determination on whether the programs meet other states' educational/licensure requirements.

Georgia Career Institute does not provide training activities out-of-state. All programs offered at the institution lead to professional licensure in the State of Georgia for our Main Campus, and the State of Tennessee at our Branch Campus. All students, including those who live in bordering states, are notified prior to enrollment that the education received here that Georgia Career Institute follows the the state specific minimum hour requirements, with the exception of Nail Technology, as listed below:

Georgia: 1500 Clock Hours Cosmetology, 1,000 Clock Hours Esthetics, 620 Clock Hours Nail Technology, 750 Clock Hours Cosmetology Instructor, 500 Clock Hours Esthetics Instructor

Tennessee: 1500 Clock Hours Cosmetology, 750 Clock Hours Esthetics, 620 Clock Hours Nail Technology, 300 Clock Hours Cosmetology Instructor

The institution makes information available to students and applicants regarding the hour requirements in other states (via the Consumer Information disclosure page on our website) and recommends that all applicants and students familiarize themselves with the comparison of other states' regulations and hours required for licensure, as applicable.

Students are required to complete all practical on campus, as we do not enroll strictly distance students who reside in other states.

Additionally, the Transfer Policy indicates that "Georgia Career Institute does not guarantee transferability of hours earned to any other institution." Per the transfer policy on our website and in our catalog, our curriculums have not been reviewed for compliance with other states' professional licensure requirements.

The institution utilizes Pivot Point curriculum for its programs, a nationally standardized curriculum authorized through PSI testing, who is the official licensure testing provider in GA and TN.
